

First Reconciliation

The Archdiocese has established the following requirements in order for an individual to receive the sacrament of First Reconciliation:

- A child must be at least **seven years** of age (may be older).
- Provide a **certificate** of Baptism for the child.
- The child must be **enrolled and attending** an approved religious education class for their grade level.
- A parent must attend the initial **parent meeting** for preparation.
- Attendance at the two designated **parent-child meetings**.
- Sufficiently **prepare** the child for First Reconciliation using the resources provided by the parish.

The Archdiocese has established the following requirements in order for a child to be considered a candidate for the reception of First Holy Communion:

- The child and at least one parent or guardian are expected to participate in **Sunday Mass** each week.
- The child must be at least **seven years** of age, having made their First Reconciliation.
- The child must be **enrolled and attending** an approved religious education class for their grade level.
- A parent must attend the initial **parent meeting** for preparation.
- Attendance at the two designated **parent-child meetings**.
- Sufficiently **prepare** the child for First Communion using the resources provided by the parish.
